Conditions of Entry

Ammunition. T.R. Any 7.62/308 max bullet weight 155 grains, .223/5.56mm, .303 F
Class. All ammunition must conform to the standard limitations of Gallery Ranges in
respect of muzzle energy (i.e.4500J) max calibre 8mm. Competitors may be asked to have
their ammunition examined. 7.62 target ammunition will be available for sale on the day.
Unfired rounds **MUST** be returned or entered on your FAC before you leave the range.

Classes

- "X" all competitors classed "X" or "A" by the NRA.
- "O" all those not "X". "A" or "T"
- "T" all those who have never won a prize in an open event or the ORA "Tyro
Tankard"
- "F" any competitor using an "F" Class Rifle. "F" Class permits any sights and rifle
rested. See also NRA rule 164 and "Ammunition" above.
- "S" Service Rifle Class Any Service rifle with open sights.

Late entries and entries on the day will only be accepted if space permits. Any entries
received after Saturday 25th September will attract an additional late entry fee of £2.

Duties All competitors will be asked to mark a target or carry out some other specified
duty. If you are disabled and cannot mark, please indicate on the form.
